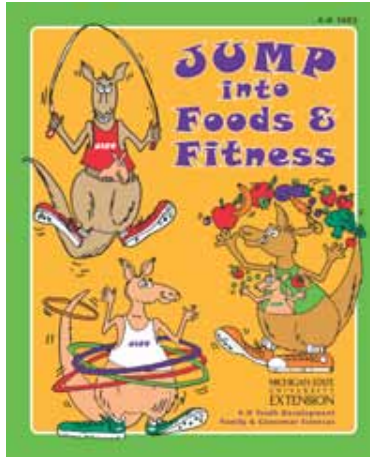


Afterschool Staff and Educators
